OBSESSION AT ITS MOST DANGEROUS.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

Although Covid-19 remains mostly in the background, with "The Grand Bolero" I wanted to explore our aching need for human connection and touch during the pandemic.

We wrote and shot the film in northern Italy, during the lockdown. Thanks to our producers and film commissions we were able to shoot in locations where Covid-19 first spread such as Lodi (in the chapel of the main hospital) and Bergamo's surroundings.

The pipe organ world is the most obsessive passion I've ever known. Roxanne's character is inspired by a real organist I met at the beginning of the pandemic. Just like her, he lives inside organs, moving from church to church repairing these fascinatingly complex instruments.

The Grand Bolero was also a great opportunity to showcase my own obsession for classical music in films. The soundtrack has been recorded on three different types of organs including the *Grand Organ of Villasanta* (one of the biggest symphonic organs in Italy) and on a Mighty Wurlitzer (currently the only theatre organ in Italy).

Lastly, I think that more than ever today, we need to celebrate the history of Cinema and its psychic power. Therefore, with this first feature, I tried my best to reconcile the modern Cinema (stereotype-free female protagonists, method performances, taboos, edgy styles) with the classic silent Cinema (at the very beginning, films were often scored by pipe organs).

LIDIA VITALE AS "ROXANNE"

Lidia Vitale was born in Rome the 12th of October. She Graduated in Social Sciences – Communication and Mas Media at La Sapienza of Rome. She has been studying acting since 1989 with several members from the **Actors' Studio** such as **Michael Margotta**, **Susan Batson**, **Doris Hicks**, **Geraldine Baron**, **Elisabeth Kemp** and **Mary Setrakian**. In the 2011, she moved to Los Angeles to create, together with **Eva Minemar**, the play "**Solo Anna**": a one woman show about the life of **Anna Magnani**. Since her debut in Los Angeles in 2012 she travelled with her show around the world, gaining great reviews. Now Lidia is committed to realize a feature film on the life of this great woman.

In Europe, Lidia starred as the leading actress in "Tulipani" directed by the dutch oscar winner Mike Van Diem.

In 2018 she starred in "Nonnas on the Run" alongside Claudia Cardinale and in "Piccole Adventure Romane", a short film about the academy award winning director Paolo Sorrentino.

In 2020 she played "Roxanne", the lead role in Gabriele Fabbro's "The Grand Bolero", and starred in the Netflix TV Series "Luna Park".

Other known roles she played: Giovanna Carati, the judge in *The Best of Youth* directed by *M.T. Giordana* (uncertain regard Cannes 2012); Francesca in *Cose da Pazzi*; *Tiger Boy* (ten short list Oscar 2012) and many others.

Roles in TV: Medicina Generale, I liceali 2, Baciato dal Sole, Suburra, Leonardo, etc.









GABRIELE FABBRO DIRECTOR

Gabriele Fabbro was born in 1996, in Milan, Italy. He's a film director with a BFA degree in Filmmaking from the **New York Film Academy** (Los Angeles). Since 2011, he wrote, directed and produced over 25 productions including short films, music videos, documentaries and commercials. Among his most recent works, he directed the music video "If You Run (2020)" for Josh Homme (Queens of the Stone Age). His latest short film "8 (2019)" screened at the 76 Venice Film Festival under the Giornate Degli Autori program. The Grand Bolero is his first fictional feature.

FULVIO BIAVASCHI PRODUCER

Fulvio Biavaschi is a producer born and raised in Milan. he has a master degree in business and management for cinema. Despite his young age, he has already accumulated national and international experience in the production of audiovisual products for cinema, television, and advertising, working in many cities such as Milan, Rome, Prague, Bogota, and Bologna. Among his clients, there are prestigious brands such as *Lamborghini*, *Bayern*, *Toyota*, *Rai*, and *Mediaset*. In 2019 he created, as producer for "*SKY Italia*", the TV series "*The Unbreakable*" broadcasted in prime time in 2020. Since 2018 he has been the project manager for *C.P.A.*, the Italian association of production companies.



Ydalie Turk is a South-African actress graduated with a BFA in Acting at the **New York Film Academy** (Los Angeles). She starred in many of Gabriele's films. "The Grand Bolero" is their first shared writing project.

JESSICA LA MALFA CINEMATOGRAPHER

Jessica La Malfa is an Italian Cinematographer graduated from **New York Film Academy**. The Grand Bolero is her first feature debut.







SEAN GOLDMAN COMPOSER

Sean Goldman is a composer and multi-instrumentalist who specializes in writing music for visual media. He holds a Master's degree in scoring for film, television and video games from the **Berklee College of Music** and a Bachelor's in classical composition from the **University of Toronto**. His style reflects classic orchestral traditions combined with modern scoring techniques. His inspirations span from Debussy to Ennio Morricone and many others.

MARTINO LURANI CERNUSCHI COMPOSER

Martino Lurani Cernuschi is part of the Lurani family (one of the few most ancient and noble families from Milan, Italy). He works in the Auction business and he's a serial collector of tower clock's engines and historical instruments. He's also deeply obsessed with classical music and pipe organs. He started playing pipe organs since he was 15 years old. His collection of pipe organs includes a 2 keyboard Wurlitzer, currently the only theatre organ available in Italy. With "The Grand Bolero" Martino is now starting his career as film composer.

PAOLO SANVITO COMPOSER

Paolo Sanvito is an Italian organist from Monza-Brianza. He's a humble passionate of pipe organs. He helped building **the grand organ of Villasanta** (one of the biggest symphonic organ in Italy). Paolo has been a key role in the making of this film. He was the first to introduce Gabriele into the strange world behind pipe organs.







SERENA VIGANÒ PRODUCTION DESIGNER AND WARDROBE

Serena Vigano is a production designer and illustrator based in Milan, Italy. She was born in 1996 and grew up with love, paper and crayons. She graduated as Interior Designer at the *Politecnico di Milano*. Since 2018 she took various classes to improve her drawing skills while working as animator for music videos and and for children's illustrations. As production designer, Serena worked in various short films in US, commercials in Italy and on "The Grand Bolero" (her first feature debut).

EDOARDO SMERILLI ASSISTANT DIRECTOR


